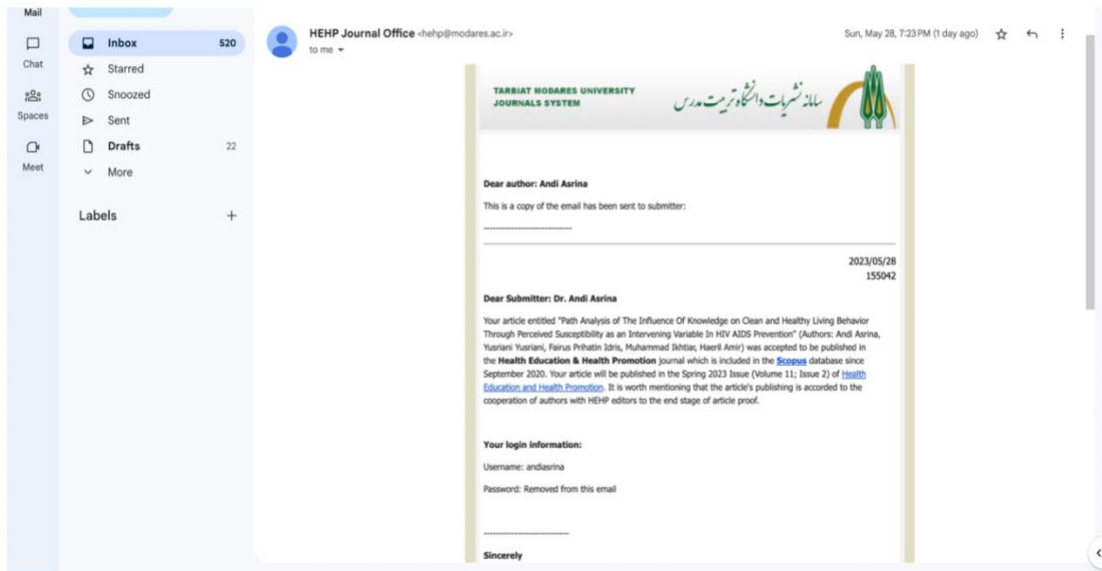
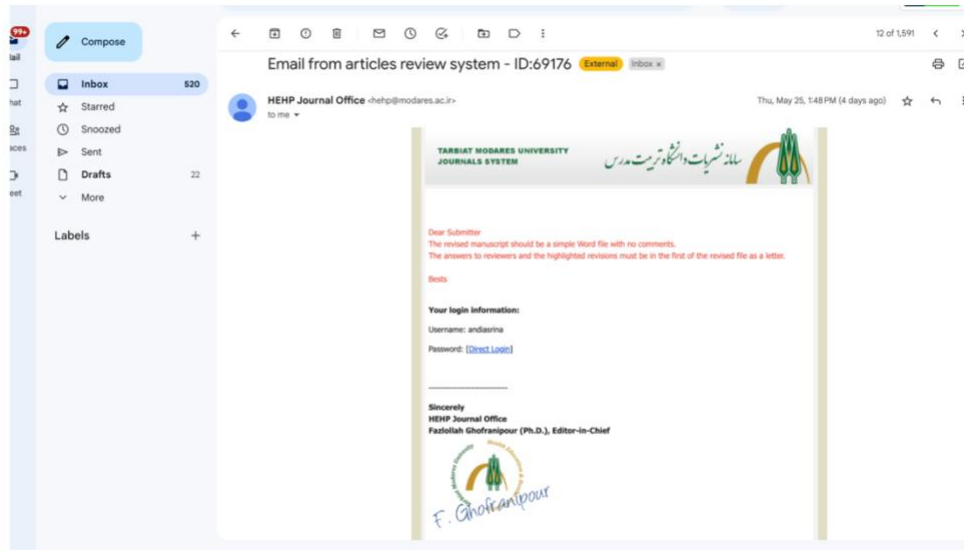

Please revise (Major) your manuscript according to the below comments.
Please notice that you must start the revised file with a letter to the Editor-in-Chief and bring the reviewers' comments and your answers to each comment precisely after it and address the revised parts in the text (mention the color of highlights). The revised parts must be highlighted in the text.

Reviewers Comments:

- 1- The abstract must be less than 250 words.
- 2- The introduction is weak and should be improved.
- 3- Remove Fig 1.
- 4- The article can not have hypotheses! Remove them all and do not use the word "hypothesis" in all the text.
- 5- The aim of the article must be written in the past tense in one sentence at the end of the introduction.
- 6- The methods section was written very weakly. Time of the study? Place? Population? How did you calculate the sample number? How did you do sampling? Which instruments were used to gather data? describe them all.
- 7- The findings can not be started with a Table! Describe the demographic data.
- 8- Data from Fig 2 is repeated in Table 2. One must be removed.
- 9- Data of the instruments must be reported completely in the findings section.
- 10- Where is Table 3?
- 11- Table 4 must be removed and data can be in the text.
- 12- The findings section must be rewritten completely.
- 13- The discussion is mostly unrelated and is like an introduction! There are very few comparisons.
- 14- The Conclusion must be short and just speak about the aims. No more or less.
- 15- The references list must be revised and added.
